Vancouver: Unless otherwise notified, candidates writing in Vancouver are to report to the Sandman Vancouver City Centre Hotel (Moxie's restaurant Ballroom), 180 West Georgia, Vancouver V6B 4P4. Registration will open at 8:00 a.m. for morning exams and 12:30 p.m. for the afternoon exams. **All exams will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.**

Edmonton: Candidates writing in Edmonton will write at the Law Society of Alberta (Edmonton), Suite 800, Bell Tower, 10104 – 103 Avenue, Edmonton (AB). Registration opens at 8:00 a.m. for morning exams and 12:30 p.m. for afternoon exams. **All exams will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.**

Calgary: Candidates writing in Calgary must report to security desk at the University of Calgary, Downtown Campus, 906 – 8th Avenue SW, Calgary, AB T2H 1H9 (Exam rooms: 316, 430, 432). Registration opens at 8:00 a.m. for morning exams and 12:30 p.m. for afternoon exams. **Exams will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.**

Regina: Candidates writing in Regina (SK) will be writing in the Poplar Room of the Ramada Plaza Hotel at 1818 Victoria Ave., Regina. **All exams will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively;** please arrive early for exam sign-in.

Winnipeg: Candidates writing in Winnipeg will be writing in the Manitoba Room 322 of the Best Western Charter House Hotel at 330 York Avenue, Winnipeg. **All exams will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively;** please arrive early for exam sign-in.

Toronto: Registration for all exams opens at 7:00 a.m. for morning exams and 12:00 p.m. for afternoon exams. Candidates must be in their seats by 8:15 a.m. and 12:45 p.m. respectively for introductory announcements. **The exams will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.**
