Registration opens at 8:00 a.m. for morning exams and 12:30 p.m. for afternoon exams. **All exams will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.**

Calgary: Unless otherwise notified, candidates writing in Calgary must report to the security desk at the **University of Calgary, Downtown Campus (exam room: 416)**, 906 – 8th Avenue SW, Calgary, AB T2H 1H9. Registration opens at 8:00 a.m. for morning exams and 12:30 p.m. for afternoon exams. **Exams will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.**

Regina: Candidates writing in Regina will be writing at the **Ramada Plaza Hotel (Pine Room)** 1818 Victoria Ave., Regina SK S4P 0R1. **All exams will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively;** please arrive early for exam sign-in.

Candidates must be in their seats by **8:15 a.m. and 12:45 p.m.** respectively for announcements.

Candidates not in their seat at that time, must wait until the announcements are completed and the exams distributed to be seated; no additional time will be provided. The exams will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. respectively.

Candidates not in their seat by the required time will have to wait until the announcements have been completed and the exams circulated before being seated; no additional time will be provided.

Alternate Approved Sites: Candidates writing at select approved locations not indicated above must contact the relevant institution for details concerning the exam locations and start times. It is the responsibility of each candidate to ensure they have the correct information pertaining to their exams, including location and additional fees (if applicable) etc.
